BIRTH CONTROL/ TESTING

Planned Parenthood provides a full range of professional, confidential reproductive health care services for the community regardless of age, gender or income. Services include birth control, HIV testing, pap tests, pregnancy testing and more; 801-226-5246.

Utah County Health Department provides low cost confidential testing, counseling, education and birth control. Treatment for certain STD's are also available; 801-851-7000.

CANCER SERVICES

American Cancer Society provides relief to those who suffer from any type of cancer; 801-493-4700.

Camp Kesem offers a peer-support network and a free summer camp for children ages 6-18 who have been affected by a parent's cancer; apply online at campkesem.org/byu.

Utah County Wellness Clinic provides free skin screenings throughout the year and low-cost and no-cost cancer screenings for women ages 40-64; call 801-851-7038.

Utah Valley Hospital offers a support group for women who are currently experiencing cancer, or who are survivors of cancer; 801-357-7575.

COMMUNITY CLINICS/ IMMUNIZATIONS

Health Clinics of Utah provides a primary health care facility to all people, including those on Medicare, Medicaid, CHIP, and PCN. Those without health insurance will pay set rate; 801-374-7011.

Mountainlands Family Health Center provides primary healthcare services, immunizations, and more. Offers sliding scale fee for those that are uninsured after interview. Also accepts Medicaid and Medicare insurance; 801-429-2000.

Volunteer Care Clinic provides free basic health care services for low-income and uninsured residents of Utah County on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 5 pm - 7 pm at 591 South State Street in Provo; 801-812-8094.

DENTAL

Community Health Connect provides dental care to low-income, uninsured Utah County residents through a network of dentists who provide free care in their own offices; 801-818-3015.

Half Price Dental provides professional dental services for approximately half the cost of the national average; 801-426-0774.

Mountainlands Community Health Center provides comprehensive dental care. Medicaid and most insurances accepted, sliding scale fee based on family size and income may be available after interview; 801-429-2000.

UVU Dental Hygiene Clinic offers discount dental cleanings for adults and children. \$25 for adults, \$15 for children; 801-863-7608.

NAVIGATOR PROGRAMS

Community Health Connect provides professional navigators who are able to explain and help individuals select insurance options; 801-818-3015.

Utah Health Policy Project helps consumers enroll in public and private insurance, and educated consumers on how to make the best use of their benefits; 801-433-2299.
