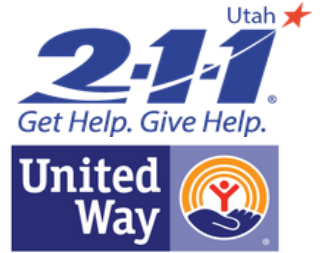


Six County Resource Guide
